

Cairo American College (CAC) provides students with a rigorous co-curricular education of exceptional quality. Tuition and fees paid by families are essential to fulfilling the CAC Mission and providing a safe and welcoming campus for all students. Our tuition rates and fees are competitive with those of our peer schools in the European Council of International Schools (ECIS), The Near East South Asia Council of Overseas Schools (NESAS), and the National Association of Independent Schools (NAIS). All fees must be paid in USD with the exception of busing fees and fees paid for students enrolled as Egyptian citizens.

## Fixed One-Time Fees

Payment Type	Amount	Description
<b>Application Fee</b>	\$350	This non-refundable fee is due with the submission of an application. This fee helps to cover administrative costs of application processing. It can be paid via wire transfer or in person at the Cashier's Window in the Welcome Center on campus.
<b>Registration Fee</b>	\$11,700	Payment for students entering grades K-12 is due in full with the first tuition payment. Pre-Kindergarten families may pay when a child enters PreK or at the rate that is in effect when the child enters Kindergarten. The registration fee is refundable if a student is withdrawn within the first 10 days of attendance.
<b>Admission Fee</b>	\$1,000	This non-refundable deposit reserves a student's place until the first day of the semester and is credited to tuition upon enrollment. If admitted <u>before August 16</u> , this deposit is due within 15 calendar days of receiving an offer of admission. For students admitted <u>after August 16</u> , this deposit is due with tuition payment prior to a student's enrollment.

## Tuition Fees

Tuition payments are due August 16. For students admitted after August 16, tuition payment is due the day before a student begins attending classes. The head of school or a designee may approve a written request for other payment options. All tuition payments are refundable within 10 days of a student beginning classes. A late payment fee is applicable after the first 10 working days of each semester. The late fee is \$100 within the first 30 calendar days, \$200 within 31 to 60 calendar days, and \$300 within 61 to 90 calendar days. After 90 calendar days, the student will not be authorized to enter school.

If the annual tuition for a student has been paid and the student withdraws before the second semester, the head of school has the discretion to refund up to 50% of the amount of the annual tuition payment. In the event of *force majeure* that causes a student to withdraw from the school, tuition and fees already paid for the school year will not be refunded. Any unpaid tuition and fees will be due and payable. This policy is necessary to protect the school's financial interests and ensure continued operations after the *force majeure* event has passed.

\*Payment for the CAC's optional Pre-Kindergarten After School Care is nonrefundable and due in the first 10 days of every semester.

## Additional Annual Fees

Payment Type	Amount	Description
<b>Tuition Deposit (Returning Students)</b>	\$1,000	This deposit is due by May 4 and credited to tuition for the next school year. Continued enrollment is not guaranteed for students for whom this deposit is not paid. In the event of cancellation, August applicants may receive a full refund only if a written request is submitted to the CAC Accounting Office by May 18. After this date, no refund will be given.
<b>Annual Capital Fee (Returning Students)</b>	\$270	This money contributes to the school's fund to support future capital projects. It is refundable within 10 days of a child beginning classes.
<b>Plant Fee (All Students)</b>	\$630	This fee contributes to campus maintenance. It is refundable within 10 days of a child beginning classes.

## Busing Fees

Cairo American College works to ensure that all students have access to safe and convenient transportation from their homes to the campus in Maadi. The annual bus fee is \$1,200 for students living inside Maadi and \$2,200 for students living outside Maadi. These fees are payable in Egyptian pounds. Busing fees are not prorated and are refundable within the first 10 days of school.

## Additional Fees

Additional payments may be required for co-curricular activities such as student clubs, athletic teams, and school trips such as Week Without Walls and Prime Trips. Financial aid is available for certain programs such as International School Sports Tournaments. Other expenses may include fees for IB and AP exams, college applications, graduation caps and gowns, or loss or damages to school property. These fees are billed separately and not included in tuition.
