



- Update on the EE-TOK Matrix and Failing Conditions (NEW for 2015!)

Failing Conditions – the full IB Diploma

- 1. CAS requirements have not been met.
- 2. Candidate's total points are fewer than 24.
- 3. An "N" has been given for Theory of Knowledge, Extended Essay or for a contributing subject.
- 4. A grade E has been awarded for *one or both* of Theory of Knowledge and the Extended Essay.
- 5. There is a grade 1 awarded in a subject/level.
- 6. Grade 2 has been awarded three or more times (HL or SL).
- 7. Grade 3 or below has been awarded four or more times (HL or SL).
- 8. Candidate has gained fewer than 12 points on HL subjects (for candidates who register for four HL subjects, the three highest grades count).
- 9. Candidate has gained fewer than 9 points on SL subjects (candidates who register for two SL subjects must gain at least 5 points at SL).

The following new matrix has been adopted from the May 2015 session onwards.

Changes from the current matrix:

B + C combination now results in 2 additional points (previously 1 point)

A + E combination now results in zero points and a failing condition (previously 1 point)







