2015 Results: Participation

Of 2015 graduates, **39% were full IB Diploma** and 94% registered for at least one IB course Highest in at least the last 7 years.

The average number of IB courses registered per student was **4.03**

Highest in the last 3 years

During the AP testing session, **138 exams** were taken by 82 students

Highest in the last 3 years



2015 IB Results: CAC vs. the World

CAC achieved a 97% pass rate for the IB Diploma against a world average of 79%

...and 37% of students earned a 35 or better Highest in at least the last 7 years

Of the subjects offered at CAC, **76**% earned a higher score than the world average for that subject Second highest in at least the last 7 years

Students earned an average of **1.7** additional points from the Extended Essay and Theory of Knowledge Highest average to date

Also, regionally CAC is on par with other American, IB schools using AERO standards in the Middle East



2015 IB Results: Predicted Grades

In 2015, CAC teachers predicted an average of **5.00** for students who achieved an average of 4.97.

2015 IB Results: Enquiry Upon Results

Between July and August, there were **11** requests to have subject exams re-marked.

Of these, 2 resulted in an increased grade

2015 AP Results: CAC vs. the World

CAC earned an average of **3.25** against the world average of 2.84

76% of CAC scores were a 3 or higher against a world average of 58%

83% of CAC students earned at least one 3 Highest in at least 5 years
