Past Results: Participation

Of 2015 graduates, **39% were full IB Diploma** and 94% registered for at least one IB course Highest in at least the last 7 years.

The average number of IB courses registered per student was **4.03**

Highest in the last 3 years

During the AP testing session, **138 exams** were taken by 82 students

Highest in the last 3 years



Past IB Results: CAC vs. the World

CAC achieved a 97% pass rate for the IB Diploma against a world average of 79% ...and 37% of students earned a 35 or better Highest in at least the last 7 years

Of the subjects offered at CAC, **76%** earned a higher score than the world average for that subject Second highest in at least the last 7 years

Students earned an average of **1.7** additional points from the Extended Essay and Theory of Knowledge

In 2015, CAC teachers predicted an average of **5.00** for students who achieved an average of 4.97.

Past AP Results: CAC vs. the World

CAC earned an average of **3.25** against the world average of 2.84

76% of CAC scores were a 3 or higher against a world average of 58%

83% of CAC students earned at least one 3 Highest in at least 5 years

Registration: IB Fees

- Must be enrolled in an IB Course
- Candidate Fee (\$170) + Subject Fee (\$130)
- Change Fee of \$50 through Jan. 15, \$150 after

Registration: AP Fees

- Anyone can register for an AP Exam
- Subject Fee (\$135)
- Late Testing Fee conflict with IB Exam (\$45)

Full IB Diploma Details: Diploma Award

24 out of 45 possible points are required

In addition the following represent failing conditions:

- CAS not completed
- Plagiarism in any subject
- Grade E in TOK or Extended Essay
- Grade of 1 in any subject
- Grade of 2 in three or more subjects
- Grade of 3 in four or more subjects
- Less than 12 points in HL subjects
- Less than 9 points in SL subjects
